In connection with the processing of personal data of A&G-Agro Korlátolt Felelősségű Társaság (hereinafter: Data Controller), as the operator of the website available under the domain name agagro.hu (hereinafter: Website), informs the Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council on the protection of individuals with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46 / EC (General Data Protection Regulation) (GDPR) April 27).

2.) RANGE OF DATA MANAGED

Data management in connection with contact

On the Website, in a special interface, the User has the opportunity to enter his / her data in order to contact the Data Controller and to receive information about the services of the Data Controller. The following personal information is required during the contact:

- full name
- e-mail address
- phone number
- message

The controller shall process the personal data of natural persons who come into contact with or are related to it as a non-contracting party, as defined above, in order to be able to carry out its activities properly and to establish and maintain a connection in this connection.

The processing is carried out with the voluntary and express consent of the data subject. The consent is given on the Data Controller's website by filling in the Contact Form and reading and accepting this information electronically at the same time.

Legal basis for data management:

When visiting the website, in the "Contact" menu, you have the opportunity to contact the Data Controller and send a message electronically. The submitted message will be processed and will be contacted in a reply message on the subject in which you sent the message.

The Data Controller will not use your personal data for purposes other than those described.

Time of data management:

He shall manage during and after the contact for as long as the contact with the natural person concerned is necessary for the performance of his activity.

Personal data will be deleted at the same time as the purpose of the data processing or at the request of the data subject.

Data management in connection with the conclusion and performance of a lawyer's contract is considered to be a contract by which a natural person, legal entity or organization without legal personality entrusts the data controller with the activity of a lawyer.

The purpose of its data management is the conclusion and performance of the contract of assignment, as well as the verification of the rights and obligations related thereto, as well as the enforcement of the rights arising therefrom, and the communication related to the conclusion and performance of the contract.

The data controller handles the following personal data of the natural person concluding the contract with him/her: name, address, mailing address, tax identification number, (tax number), telephone number, e-mail and other personal data related to the conclusion and performance of the contract.

Legal basis for data management:

Performing activities at the request of the contractor prior to concluding the contract, performing the contract after the conclusion of the contract until its termination in case of failure to conclude the contract, and after the termination of the contract the data controller has a legitimate interest in enforcing any claims related to the contract; or, in the case of an inspection, can demonstrate the adequacy of its procedure.

Time of data management:

In the event of the conclusion of the contract, during the period thereof, after the failure to conclude the contract or after the termination of the contract, the data controller shall process the personal data until otherwise, in connection with the failure to conclude the contract or after its conclusion - a claim may be enforced against or against it.

The natural person concerned by the processing may object at any time to the processing of the data on the basis of a legitimate interest.

Data management in connection with the fulfillment of an obligation specified in law In order to fulfill the obligation specified in the law related to its activities, the data controller manages the personal data of natural persons in connection with the contracts specified therein. Such obligations include in particular:

- Act LIII of 2017 on the Prevention and Suppression of Money Laundering and Terrorist Financing. identification in accordance with the Act ("Pmt.")
- performing secondments and related tasks
- identification of third parties involved in the execution of orders, secondments, contact with these persons, communication, preparation / conclusion of agreements
- commission fee and cost accounting, invoicing
- case records
- records management in accordance with its own administrative and legal obligations
- concluding, performing and settling contracts with persons involved in the activities of a lawyer or facilitating it

3.) ENTITLED TO ACCESS PERSONAL DATA, DATA PROCESSING

The Data Controller and the Data Processors used by it have the right to get acquainted with the personal data in accordance with the applicable legal regulations. The processing of data is performed by the following data processor acting on behalf of the Data Controller:

The purpose of data processing is hosting services.

Unless expressly provided by law, the Data Controller shall only transfer personally identifiable data to third parties with the express consent of the data subject.

4.) RIGHTS OF THE PERSON CONCERNED

- Receive transparent information about the processing of your data and receive feedback on the progress of your data processing, as well as the information contained in the transparent information. (GDPR Article 15)
- Correct inaccurate personal data about him or her or supplement incomplete personal data. (GDPR Article 16)
- Delete personal data about him. (GDPR Article 17)
- Upon request, the Data Controller restricts data processing. (GDPR Article 18)
- You will receive your personal data in an appropriate format and transfer it to another data controller. (GDPR Article 12)

5.) GETTING TO KNOW THE DATA

During the period of data management, the employees employed by the Data Controller may get acquainted with the data affected by the data management for the time and to the extent necessary for the performance of their duties, subject to the obligation of confidentiality.

6.) DATA SECURITY

The controller undertakes to ensure the security of the data, to take the technical and organizational measures and to establish procedures to ensure that the data recorded, stored or processed are protected and to prevent their destruction, unauthorized use and use. unauthorized alteration.

The data controller shall ensure that the processed data cannot be accessed, disclosed, transmitted, modified or deleted by unauthorized persons. The processed data may only be

accessed by the relevant employees of the Data Controller, they shall not be passed on by the Data Controller to a third party who is not entitled to access the data.

The data controller will do everything in its power to ensure that the data is not accidentally damaged or destroyed. The Data Controller also imposes the above commitment on the employees participating in the data management activities.

Under no circumstances shall the controller collect special data, ie data relating to racial origin, membership of a national or ethnic minority, political opinion or party affiliation, religious or other belief, membership of an advocacy organization, state of health, pathology, sex life as well as a criminal record.

7.) LINKS

The Data Controller is not responsible for the content, data and information protection practices of external websites available as a jumping point from the Website. If the Data Controller becomes aware that the site or linking to it infringes the rights of third parties or applicable law, it will immediately remove the link from the website.

8.) ENFORCEMENT OPTIONS

The Data Controller makes every effort to ensure that personal data is processed in accordance with the relevant legislation, however, if the data subject feels that this has not been complied with, he or she has the opportunity to write to 6720 Szeged, Arany János u. 7th postal address.

If the data subject feels that his or her right to the protection of personal data has been violated, he or she may lodge a complaint (complaint) with the competent authority in accordance with the applicable law.

National Data Protection and Freedom of Information Authority (seat: 1055 Budapest, Falk Miksa utca 9-11., Postal address: 1363 Budapest, Pf. 9.) or at the data protection supervisory authority of the Member State of the habitual residence, place of work or place of the alleged infringement, if the data subject considers that the processing of your personal data violates the General Data Protection Regulation.

The data subject has the right to bring legal proceedings before the court having jurisdiction over the data controller's place of business or before the court of the EU Member State of the data subject's habitual residence if the data controller has infringed his or her rights under the applicable law. In Hungary, the person concerned may also file a lawsuit before the court of his or her place of residence or stay.
